

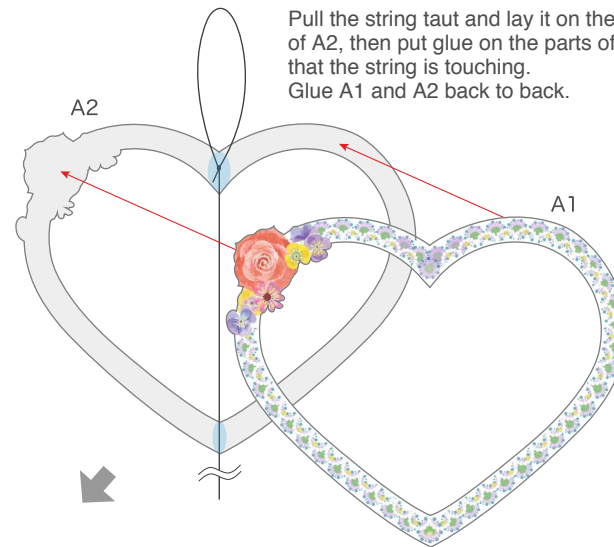


Instructions

① Assemble A1 to D2.

Tie a knot in the string about 100 mm from the end to make a circle.

*Adjust the circle to your preferred length.

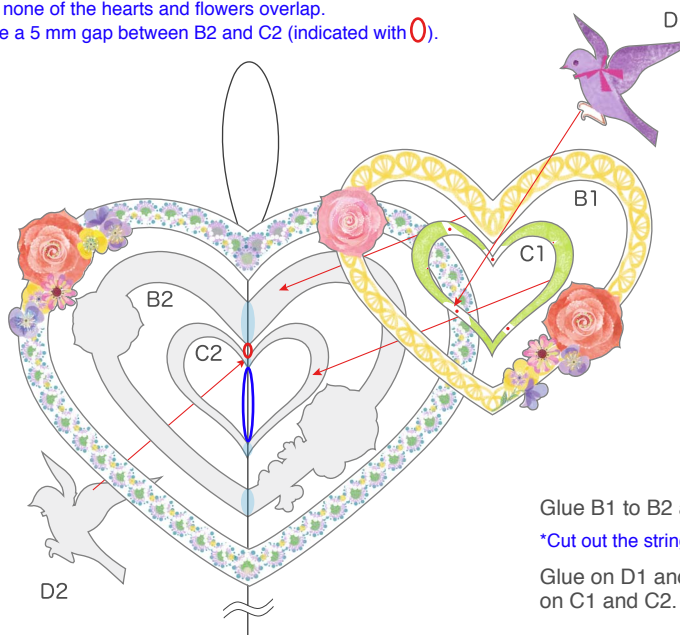


Pull the string taut and lay it on the reverse side of A2, then put glue on the parts of A2 that the string is touching. Glue A1 and A2 back to back.

Place B2 and C2 on top as shown in the diagram and glue on the string in the same way as with A2.

*Make sure that none of the hearts and flowers overlap.

*Be sure to leave a 5 mm gap between B2 and C2 (indicated with O).



Glue B1 to B2 and C1 to C2 back to back.

*Cut out the string inside heart C (indicated with O).

Glue on D1 and D2, matching them to the glue spots on C1 and C2.

Notation Key

— Cut line ● Glue spot

You will need

Scissors, glue, ruler, string (white)

Caution

Glue, scissors and other tools may be dangerous to young children so be sure to keep them out of the reach of young children.

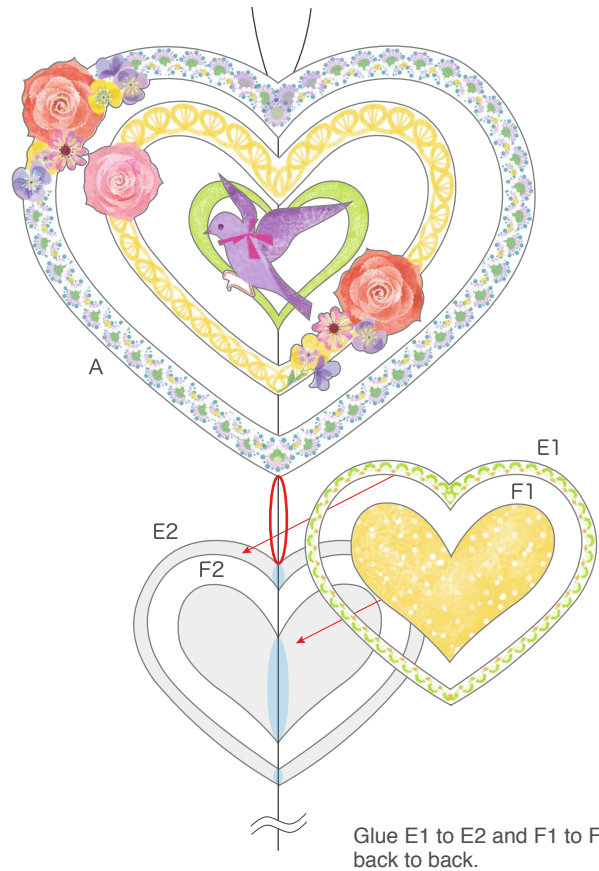
Be careful not to cut your fingers when using scissors.

② Assemble E1 to F2.

Place E2 and F2 on top as shown in the diagram and glue on the string.

*Make sure that none of the hearts overlap.

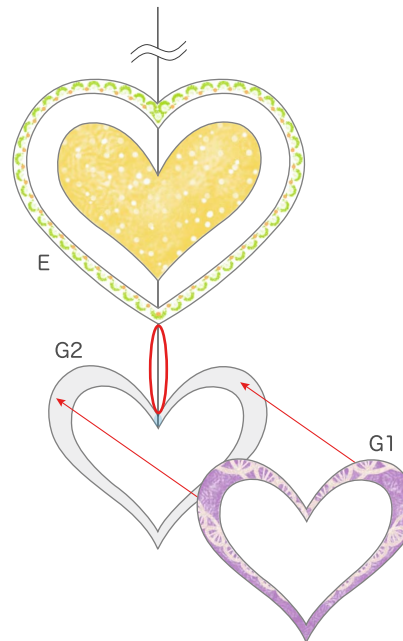
*Be sure to leave a 25 mm gap between A and E (indicated with 0).



③ Assemble G1 and G2.

Place G2 on top as shown in the diagram and glue on the string.

*Be sure to leave a 25 mm gap between E and G (indicated with 0).



Glue G1 and G2 back to back.

*Cut off the extra length of string.

④ Complete

Hang it wherever you like and enjoy.
